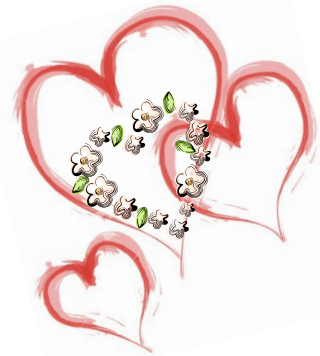
School Closed
