ATTENTION PARENTS/ GUARDIANS:

In case of an emergency, the school office needs to contact parents or guardians. Please make sure that we have up-to-date emergency numbers in your child's file. We need your current home & work telephone numbers, and the number of at least one other person who can assume responsibility for your child.

We ask that you keep an eye out for any signs of infections in your child that may spread to other children and staff. Please notify us if your child has been ill at home during the morn-



ing, evening or weekend before dropping your child off at school. In the event that your child has a contagious illness, we ask that you keep them at home to obtain the rest and care needed to regain their good health.

Medication may only be administered by our staff if it is in its original container, labeled clearly with the child's name, dosages and times. Medication should never be placed in a child's lunch box or backpack. If medication needs to be refrigerated, please inform the school director immediately. If medication does not require refrigeration, it will be stored in the secured medicine box provided by the school.
