SCHOOL POLICIES & PROCEDURES

GENERAL HEALTH POLICY

We are concerned about the well being of all our children, please keep your child at home if he/she is ill. It is imperative that we take the extra precautions to prevent diseases among the children and staff.

1. In accordance with Title 22, Section 101326, 1, all children will go under a Health Check each morning.

The teacher in charge will take a moment to talk to and visually observe each child.

2. A child who has experienced any contagious disease or infection may return to school only with a doctor's note and after being treated for at least 24 hours. Especially but not limited to the following:

- Conjunctivitis(Pink Eye)
- Tonsillitis
- Strep Throat
- Ring Worm
- Pin Worm
- Scarlet Fever
- Ear Infection
- Hand, Foot, and Mouth
- Roseola
- Cloudy or Green-nasal mucus

3. A child with CHICKEN POX may return to school only after all the lesions are scabbed and no new ones have formed (a minimum of 7 days). A physician's release is required for the following contagious diseases: chicken pox, roseola, measles, conjunctivitis or any other eye infection, mumps, or body rashes, in order to return to school.

When a student becomes ill at school, the following procedures will be followed:

If a child is running a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or more, vomiting, diarrhea, or upper respiratory infection, the parents, will be contacted to have the child removed from the school no longer than one hour after being notified.

Infants 24 months or younger must be picked up within 30 minutes of being called. Alternative arrangements are responsibility of the parents in cases where they are unable to pick-up the sick student.

A. Dispensing Individual Medication

1. A "Medication Permission Form" must be completed and signed by a parent before medication can be given to a child. A telephone call **WILL NOT** be accepted. Arrangements can be made with the Administration regarding regularly administered medication or as needed medication.

2. If your child needs to have medicine administered during school hours, bring the medicine in its original pharmacy container clearly labeled with your child's name, type of medicine, and the dosage required.

A medicine measuring tube/cup must be placed inside a labeled zip lock bag. Medication will be administered in the office by office personnel

B. Accidents and First Aid

1. School personnel are trained to render first aid only. They do not diagnose or give medical treatment. Authorized school personnel will give first aid for minor injuries received (minor cuts, scratches, abrasions, etc.). An Incident Report Form will be completed for each incident and will be provided to the parent or caretaker. It is the parents' responsibility to follow up on all incidents.

C. Signing In and Out Procedure

1. In order to provide a safe learning environment, it is imperative that all children are signed in and signed out in the school roster daily. Each child has his/her own section in the roster page for the responsible adult (18 years or older) to sign and write in the child's arrival and departure times.

2. We release the child/children only to those individual designated on the child's "Identification and Emergency Information Form." A request by a parent to authorize release of a child must be submitted in writing to the school administrator with a parental signature. A phone call is not acceptable.

D. Attendance

Please notify the school by telephone if your child will not be attending his/her regular scheduled program for a couple of days.

E. Student's Conduct & Discipline

At Carousel Preschool, we strive to provide a positive approach to discipline. In order to achieve this, the staff uses positive language when talking to the children. When a situation arises that needs to be addressed, the staff explains what the inappropriate conduct the child is doing and uses positive language to express what actions need to take place. Re-direction is also used. This allows the child to go to another activity and to show the staff member the correct form of behavior. If constant re-direction is needed, then the child may need to have time away from the other children while under the supervision of the teacher.

F. Carousel Preschool requires age-appropriate conduct by all students.

In the event, and in the sole discretion of School Administrator, if a child's conduct presents a health or safety hazard to other students, or is unduly disruptive to the school environment; a student's enrollment may be discontinued.

G. Parent-School Communication

Parents will be informed of the latest announcements relating to the school through notices on parent sign in/out clipboards, newsletters, and general memorandums. Please read all newsletters and general memoranda so that your child does not miss any important events.

H. Tuition and Payments

Tuition is due by the 1st day of each month. A **10% fee will be charged for payments not received by the 3rd of each month.** If and when the 3rd falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or school holiday, tuition must be paid on the immediately preceding Friday to avoid late charges. Children will not be admitted to class thereafter if these financial obligations have not been met. There is a \$35.00 charge for any returned checks and all future payments must be made in cash.

STUDENT OF THE MONTH

At Carousel Preschool, we encourage all the children to always strive to the best of their abilities. We applaud their efforts by selecting one child each month from each class to be honored as the Student of the Month. The child who will be selected as the Student of the Month will be receiving a certificate of recognition and a trophy to take home.

CONTACT INFORMATION

In case of an emergency, the school office needs to contact parents or guardians. Please make sure that we have an updated emergency numbers in your child's file. We need your current home & work telephone numbers, and the number of at least one other person who can assume responsibility for your child.

IMMUNIZATIONS

One of the very important state regulations that we must follow is keeping all children's immunizations current. If your child has updated any immunizations recently, please submit a copy of their shot records to the office to be added to your child's file. We are in the process of renewing medical records and would find this very helpful.

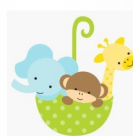
